Assessments take place in person at our Parkside or Salisbury practice. Interview and feedback sessions can be in person or telehealth.

Includes pre-assessment questionnaires, parent interview, child assessment, and feedback session.

WHAT DOES THE ASSESSMENT INCLUDE?

INFORMATION GATHERING

From sources including clinical interview and standard assessment tools.

COGNITIVE ASSESSMENT

This allows for improved diagnosis and recommendations.

COMPREHENSIVE REPORT

Including whether your child meets the diagnostic criteria, a summary of cognitive abilities (strengths, challenges) and recommendations (in-home / school strategies, any treatments or supports).

IMPORTANT NOTES



If you require the assessment for medication purposes, please note that GPs generally don't accept a diagnosis from a psychologist - only from a psychiatrist.

- ✘ We do not provide ADHD assessments for children under 6 years of age.
- ✘ 17+ years requires the adult ADHD assessment.



PAYMENT OPTIONS



Pay in full upfront

Pay in full by debit or credit card when your booking is confirmed.



Pay in 2 instalments

Pay half on confirmation of your booking and pay the remaining amount before you attend the feedback session.



Pay in 4 instalments

Pay in 4 instalments with Afterpay.

MEDICARE REBATES



You may be eligible for Medicare rebates if:

- Your child is under 25 years of age and has been referred for a diagnostic assessment by a Paediatrician, GP, or qualified practitioner, **and**
- The referral states that your child has been referred for a service that will be covered by item code 82000.

The assessment process

WHAT TO EXPECT

1. PRE-ASSESSMENT FORMS

🕒 Up to 2.5 hours (at home)

Before sessions can be scheduled, parents will need to fill in pre-assessment forms and questionnaires.

2. PARENT INTERVIEW

🕒 Up to 1 hour* in person

We gather background information about your child's developmental milestones and day-to-day behaviour.

3. CHILD ASSESSMENT

🕒 Up to 2.5 hours* in person

We complete a series of tasks and activities to understand how your child learns, thinks, and solves problems.

4. FEEDBACK SESSION

🕒 Up to 1 hour in person or via telehealth

We meet to discuss results, and go over the recommendations that we have made in your child's assessment report, with time for questions.

*If a child is old enough and able to be occupied in a shared waiting room, the parent interview can occur at the same time as the child assessment. This would then be scheduled as a 3.5 hour appointment.
